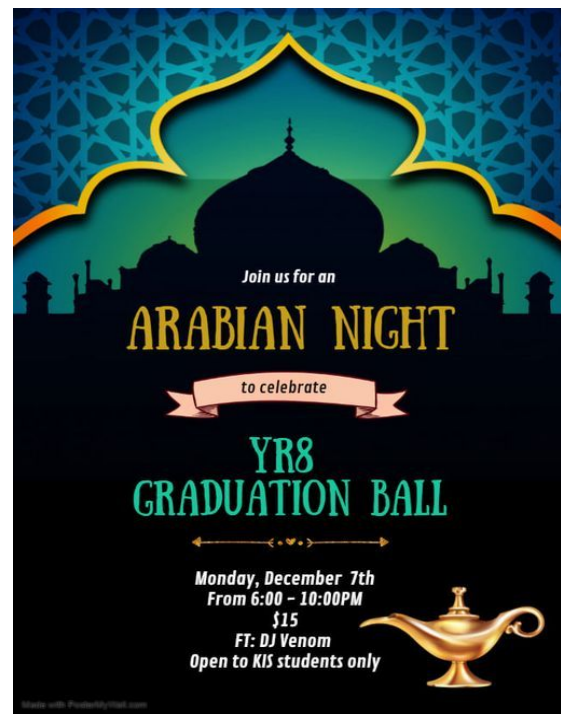
School Ball
